

Full Distance Learning Participants in Band Guidelines/Expectations and Contract

Thank you for continuing in band this year, despite it not being offered through the full distance learning program. I'm glad you want to further your abilities in music. You will need to understand that there are some guidelines and expectations that come with your ability to use your state-owned instrument.

Please read the guidelines and sign the contract below. You will need to sign the contract, have a parent/guardian sign the contract, take a photo of the contract, then e-mail it back to me at either waipahuhsband@gmail.com or henry.fu@k12.hi.us.

Grading

Please understand that as a distance learning student, you will NOT be receiving credit for band. This is a voluntary learning opportunity for you to continue your music education here at Waipahu High School that Mr. Fu is generously offering you. If you do not agree with this policy, you will need to contact Mr. Fu for a time to return your instrument to him.

Instrument

You were assigned a school instrument/practice pad/bell set. You must take proper care of it. Inform Mr. Fu if any damage has happened to your instrument. If you damage the instrument severely, you must pay for the repair.

If you lose your instrument, or if it is stolen from you, you will be required to pay the market value of the instrument, or you will not be allowed to participate in school-sponsored activities, sports, etc. You will also not be able to graduate. Please take care of your instrument!

Participation

You will be required to participate in all classwork and projects that the hybrid students are participating in. You won't be required to participate in a class period during the day. You will be placed in a Google Classroom period, but it will be utilized to distribute work and field questions.

If Mr. Fu feels you are not participating satisfactorily, he will ask you to return your instrument to the school, and you will be disenrolled from the class.

Band Handbook

You are still required to read the band handbook that has been issued to all other students.
